- The Germantown School internship program with the Town Board will continue. More information is forthcoming.
- Construction work continues on the new park at Dales Bridge. Its official name is the Roe-Jan Kill Park. There will be an official opening event.
- Work on Sewer District Pumping Station No. 2 began in late August. Sewer District residents are being asked to provide information and allow inspections of their rainwater run-off usage and hook-ups.
- The Town Board has appointed David Robinson as Sewer District Project Coordinator – a consultant position at \$0 salary. Mr. Robinson also coordinates sewer work in Greenport, Valatie, and Claverack.
- Handicapped parking spaces have been created at the front of the Kellner Community & Youth Activities Building, and signage will also be installed.
- The Town Board will schedule a procession of 2010 Budget Meetings and workshops in the near future.
- The Town is formally applying to FEMA for funds to reimburse the \$7,000 cost of the emergency replacement of a large pipe damaged in recent storms.
- An economic development committee comprised of Germantown, Clermont, and Livingston Town Supervisors plus local businesspeople is under discussion.
- ARTSPACE is happening again at the corner of Maple and Main. “Picture Books by the Crews Family,” featuring the work of Donald Crews, Ann Jonas and Nina Crews, opens Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, with a 5 PM Reception. The exhibit continues through November 1<sup>st</sup> – Saturdays 11-5 and Sundays 11-4. Volunteer gallery “sitters” are needed; please telephone Corinne Curry at 537-4469.
