

Minutes of December 11, 2018 Town of Germantown, Public Hearing, held in the Germantown Town Hall, Germantown, NY, commencing at 6:47pm.

Supervisor Beaury opened the Public Hearing and Led with the Pledge to the Flag.

Motion to open the Public Hearing made by Councilman Kukon, seconded by Councilwoman DuFresne, with all in favor and none opposed.

Town Clerk read the following public notice:

Public Hearing Town of Germantown

Notice is hereby given that on December 11, 2018 at 6:45pm the Germantown Town Board will hold a Public Hearing on proposed Local Law No. 3 of 2018 prohibiting parking of all vehicles on town streets, roads and highways from midnight to 6:00am from November 15 through March 15. The Public Hearing will be followed by the monthly Town Board meeting at the Germantown Town Hall, 50 Palatine Park Road, Germantown, NY.

Motion to open the Public Hearing made by Councilman Kukon, seconded by Councilwoman DuFresne, with all in favor and none opposed.

Supervisor Beaury gave the reasoning behind the drafting of Local Law #3 stating there is a law on the books allowing the Superintendent of Highways to declare a snow emergency in order for the roads to be cleared during a snowstorm. Local law #3 will be focusing mostly on parking in the hamlet and there will also be new rules for the municipal parking lots. There will be no parking along streets from November 15th-March 15<sup>th</sup>. This law will make it efficient and safe for the Highway department to remove snow from streets without the need to declare a snow emergency.

Supervisor opened the Public Hearing to the public.

Newspaper Reporter Carmen asked if a sign was being put up? Supervisor Beaury said signs will be placed around town which include new signs for the municipal lots and parks.

Motion to close the Public Hearing made by Councilman Kukon, seconded by Councilwoman DuFresne, with all in favor and none opposed.

Public Hearing was closed at 6:53pm.
